Travel: How to get to Newbury Showground: Priors Court Road, Hermitage, Newbury, Berks, RG18 9QZ

By road: Easy access via the M4 from South Wales or London, or the A34 from Oxford or Newbury. There is ample free on-site parking. The Showman's Show is committed to making the Show as green as possible and asks guests to consider the environment and the effect your travel has on it. By rail: to Newbury. A courtesy bus will operate between Newbury Station and the Showground every 30min from 8.30am on the 17th October. The last bus will leave the showground at 6pm on Wednesday the 17th.

By air: Heathrow is under 45 minutes drive west bound along the M4. Bristol via the M4 east bound. Southampton airport via M3 and A34.
